Our next chapter meeting is set for Wednesday, January 10th at 6pm at the Elks Lodge in the upstairs meeting room. Please plan on attending as we'll be discussing our plans for 2018. This also begins our schedule of holding a meeting every other month. However, I'm very much open to planning some kind of a social event in the "off" months. Let's chat about it at the meeting.

The end of this month will mark the 50th anniversary of the start of the Tet Offensive in South Vietnam. 1968 was a watershed year in-country, and the reverberations had a profound and lasting impact on folks back home, so much so that it changed the very nature of how America would proceed in Vietnam.

While the Viet Cong and North Vietnamese suffered terrible losses, and the South Vietnamese and American forces took heavy casualties over the next month or so without losing a single battle, the resulting psychological effect on the American public would be the turning point in a war already under siege—politically and morally—at home; eventually reaching deep inside the White House, forcing President Lyndon Johnson to give up seeking a second term.

For those us who were there at the time, little did we realize what the future held. The survivors were just glad they made it through, and, if you were a short-timer, you had your eyes skyward, looking forward to boarding that freedom bird. I'd be interested in hearing your Tet stories, no matter where you were stationed in the world at the time or if you were already mustered out and wondering what the hell was going on!

It's important that we continue to reflect on the war and its legacy, not just for those who were there, but for all who served during that time and for the generations of Americans to follow.
